





(6) Items difficult to dispose of

Contact the dealer from where you purchased the item or qualified disposal company for proper disposal. Paint, fire extinguishers, batteries, tires, gas cylinders, structural waste

materials, fittings, rocks, motorcycles, pesticides, etc.

These can damage disposal machinery.

Iron dumbbells, metal pry bars, weed-cutter blades, and other large pieces of steel/metal *Iron steel can be collected as "large-sized garbage."
